

## *Comments on Unknown Dublin Records*

Abraham Pew	d 1729 COI- St <b>Paul's Parish</b> -has to be related to the Dublin Pughs, the name is too unique.
Benjamin Pugh	Surgeon-there are only 2, but the one born in <b>Cork</b> was born in 1830, and the one who is a surgeon is in <b>Dublin</b> in 1845
Agnes Pew/Pugh/Peugh	Residence <b>Donneybrook</b> - is she related to Ellen from Donneybrook ? Born between 1831 and 1836. She is <b>RC</b> . Probably not Agnes who was born in Kilkenny 1828 to James Pugh soldier and Susan as they were COI. She is in the WH and Ellen was in prison. Ellen was born 1851 in Donneybrook. Other records from Donneybrook are COI.
Ann P Pugh	born in <b>Rathdown</b> 1951 mother was a Witt, sister to Susan b 1949 Dublin South?
Brian MS Pugh	born 1921 in <b>Rathdown</b>
Caroline Pew	b 1836 <b>Henry Street</b> (assuming that's Dublin) in prison in 1865- no one else with that address
Christopher Pugh	<b>dob abt 1930</b> m Margaret O'Neill 1954, buried in <b>Deansgrange Cemetery</b> with wife, Ellen Scott d 1971 and Elizabeth Devine d 1971
Esther Pugh	<b>dob abt 1932</b> m 1952 to Francis Buckley, William Slevin, John P Keating, Thomas B Bierne <b>Dublin South</b>
Derek and James Pugh	Father was Patrick, probably born around 1930 Mother Catherine.
Francis Pew	probate 1859 address <b>Queens Terrace</b> . Not Frances who married Anne Floyd, he was still having children up to 1872 and his death record is 1825-1895.
Francis Pugh	1847-1888 <b>Dublin North</b> no other information
Humphrey Pugh	b 1866 parents Richard Humphrey Pugh and Jane Lang, living on <b>James street</b> . Related to John Pugh and Elizabeth Leggett? Also address <b>James Street</b> possibly brother? Although Humphrey does not fit the naming pattern. Father is a skinner.
James Pue	d 1760 <b>William Street Dublin</b> (Not the printer)
James Pugh	b 1934 Mother "Pugh" <b>Dublin South</b>
John Patrick Pugh	b 1969 died at 11 days, father Patrick, ferry driver? Address <b>Slane</b> - same address as Teresa Dunne Pugh
John Pugh	<b>dob about 1830</b> lives on <b>Clarkes Court</b> 1851, <b>Parish of St Bridget</b>
John Pugh	1819-1890 died in the WH, in and out from 1878-1890, address <b>Line Street</b> when he died, also lived on <b>Sandwith</b> and <b>Townsend</b> . He was married. Possibly married to Eliza Scanlon?
John DS/Desmond Pugh	b 1918 <b>Dublin South</b>
John Christopher Pugh	<b>dob abt 1906</b> m to Margaret O'Shea 1936, his father is Bartholomew, coachman and they live on <b>Parliament Street</b> , witness William Pugh (no match in all names) and Marie O'Shea. He is a laborer. Margaret died age 25 1938, two years after marriage. He likely remarried.

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Margaret Pue NMN	died 1748 <b>Dublin</b> , intestate- must have been married to someone who was important, in Keeper of Public Records.
Margaret Pugh	1848-1850 <b>Parish of St Marks</b> . Address <b>Cumberland</b> . Probably daughter of Laurence and Rachel Boyd. They married 1843 at St Marks.
Margaret Pugh	<b>dob abt 1900</b> m 1925 <b>Dublin North</b> William Murphy, Hugh Creavy, James Mc Glynn, Michael Byrne
Mary Pugh NMN	1811-1883 widow, address <b>2 Leeson Place</b> , daughter Bridget Grenkey, same address
Mary Pugh	dob 1814 born in Abbey Leix (Laois) in Grangegorman 1844- most likely not Mary Phew below, as she would have been 92, but I suppose it is possible.
MaryAnne Pugh	dob 1840 b <b>Stephens Green</b> , Residence 3 <b>McGuinness Place</b> in prison for assault 1884. No matches.
Mary Pughe	<b>dob app 1868</b> m Frederick Patrick Walsh 1908 <b>Dublin South</b>
Mary Kate Pugh	b 1877 on census records at County Westmeath 1901, born in Dublin single- servant. RC Can read and write No matches.
Mary Pugh	<b>dob app 1880</b> m Patrick Wosser bef 1911 address Cumberland Street he was a carpenter
Mary E Pugh NMN	1897-1958 Widow <b>Dublin South</b> "Kyle" c/o ? ? Moody Kyle address <b>Kiltigan, County Wicklow</b>
Mary Phew	no dob Queen's Terrace 1906 Residence County Laois (Queens) In Mountjoy for illegal possession of brass.
May Pugh	1906-1968 died at St Kevin's Hospital 3280 N <b>Mead Blvd/Naas Bride</b> Street?
Mary Pugh	<b>dob app 1927</b> m 1947 Michael King, Thomas James Walsh, Bernard Michael Barry <b>Dublin South</b>
Mary Pugh	<b>dob app 1933</b> Michael Timmons, John T Nolan, Bernard Sower, Matthew Dent
Michael Paue	dob 1839 Single laborer in ? 20 years. No abode <b>RC</b> Workhouse Looks like it says intox 20 years 1895- died?
Nora Pugh	<b>dob abt 1909</b> m Thomas Kennedy 1929 father William Pugh address <b>Heather Hill</b> Mary Pugh witness
Olive E Pugh	dob abt 1938 m John H Cripps Lives on Dors Lane <b>Dublin South</b>
Patrick Pugh	Two of them are born 1909, with different dates of death. The first one was 20, died in 1929 "late of Fenian Street". Abraham and son Abraham lived on Fenian Street when they died, so I am assuming the first Patrick belongs with that family. The second one was 25 when he died-brother J. Pugh present at death, both addresses 54 Mountjoy Square. No one else with that address. However, the first Patrick also had a brother John....not enough evidence to conclude they are the same.
Peter Pew	b 1892 <b>Dublin South</b>
Peter Pew	Prison Records Application for interment 4.19.21 Report that he was arrested on 8.6.21 address 16 Harmony Row- awaiting decision of CMA (Court Martial Administrator)- so I am assuming they were looking for him In April and found him in August.

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Richard Pugh	b 1839-1841 b on <b>Fishamble Street</b> in prison x 2 When he was 15, for abusive language and 29 for assault with six other men.
Rosaline Pugh	dob abt 1937 m Robert Thomas, Charles King, Ciaran Murphy, Michael D Behan 1857
Sally Pugh	<b>dob app 1838</b> m Martin Nilan, Thomas Coombes, James Battersby 1858
Susan Pugh	<b>dob apt 1949 Dublin South</b> mother was a Witt, sister to Ann b 1951? <b>Rathdown</b>
Teresa Dunne Pugh	died 1993, husband of Patrick, maiden name Dunne, address <b>Firhouse</b> , formerly from <b>Slane Road</b> , Crumlin, probably mother of Patrick who died age 11.
Thomas Pugh	Two bachelors, both living on <b>Russell Place</b> . One born 1847 and one was born 1862-1916.
Thomas Pugh	1887-1936- dairyman who lived on <b>Poolbeg Street</b> . He could be related to Abraham and Mary Dunne, or to William and Catherine who had son James 1871-1880 or to Patrick and Catherine Boyle, all with the address of Poolbeg. Or was he a son of Francis and Anne Floyd and it's just a coincidence that he is on Poolbeg.
Thomas Pugh	1906-1912 son of Thomas a porter, address <b>Cumberland</b> .
William Pue	d 1760 of <b>Wickham Street Dublin</b> Wife Barbara Pue orse Hawton
William Pugh	in the paper in 1768 asking clemency for John Wilkes
William Pugh	1851 <b>Magees Court, Dublin</b>
William Pugh	b 1870 in prison age 34 Bridewell Prison
