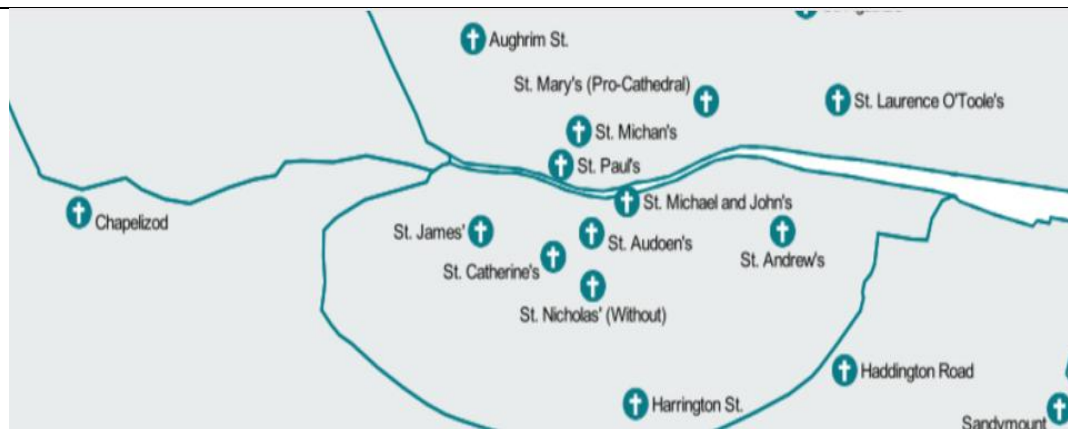


Dublin North Roman Catholic Pue / Pugh / Pughe's

- Aughrim St parish was created from St Paul's parish, Arran Quay in c.1876-1877
- St Mary's Pro-Cathedral
- St Michans
- St Laurence O'Tooles



North Dublin Pugh's/Pews/Pues-Roman Catholic

St Pauls Aran Quay

1. **George Pue** and Catherine Brown m 1775 dob **app 1755**
2. **Robert Pue** and Catherine **dob app 1787** son of George?
They have a daughter Mary b. 1817.
3. Mary Pue b 1805 St Paul's- parents unknown
4. James **Pugh** and Catherine Shea dob app 1820 – he is a soldier from County Longford

St Mary's Pro-Cathedral

1. George **Pughe** and Mary Davis m 1846 **dob apt 1820**, their daughter was Ann Jane Pugh b 1847. Civil records have them married at St Thomas Parish. He is a painter and his father Price is a teacher. Address **Northumberland**.
2. John **Pew** and Eliza Scanlan, m 1840 **dob app 1820**- possibly John Pugh unknown- who was RC, married, and in and out of the South Union WH until he died in 1819?
3. Elizabeth Mahan **Pugh** **dob app 1840** had a daughter Maria Pugh 1862. Lived on **Rutland Street**. Records say “anna nata”
Something like maiden name? I suspect she was not married.

The Glassmakers from Scotland-see separate records. Thomas married in Leith Scotland and son Richard was born there, but is that where they were from originally? They also lived in North Dublin, St Thomas Parish-most went to **St Mary's Pro-Cathedral**

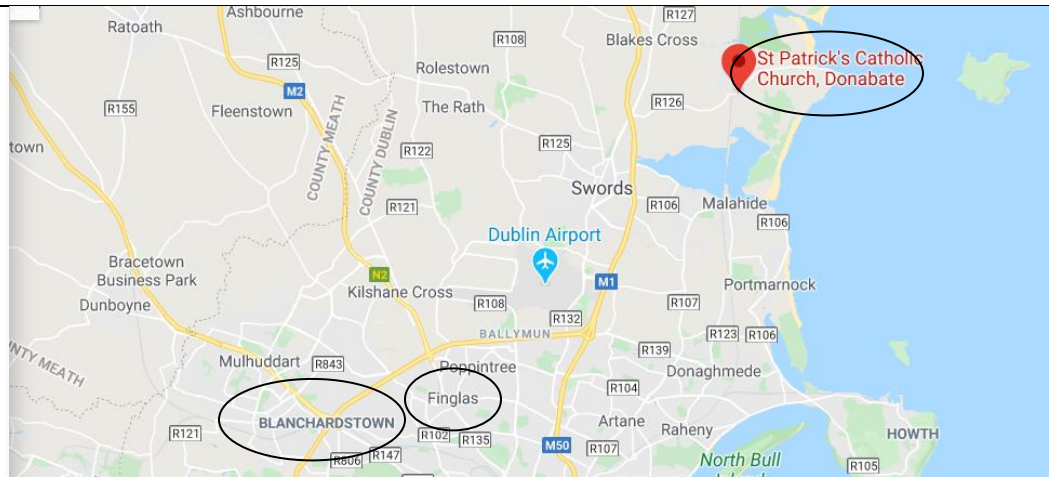
St. Laurence O'Toole's

1. Catherine **Pugh** m Michael Evans 1869 address **Charles Street**, her parents are James and Catherine
2. Emma **Pugh** b app 1850 and Hubert Phillips m bef 1876, Lived on **Commons Street**

Blanchardstown- Luke **Pue** and Mary Caffrey- **dob app 1780**- they had 5 children: Patrick Pue (1799-1899), Thomas (1802), Catherine (1803) Catherine (1806) Rose 1816. There is also a Pat **Pew** in Blanchardstown **dob app 1750** who I suspect is Luke's father, per naming pattern.

Donabate Ann Pew and Nick Anger m 1779 **dob app 1750**

I suspect Pat and Anne are siblings as there was a Pat Pew who was a witness at her wedding. Was their father a brother to Arthur? Where did the name Luke come from?



Luke Pew and Mary Caffrey and family were further north in Blanchardstown, Finglass and Rathfarnham.
