John Pew and Elizabeth NR dob appt 1795.

James born 1815.

Biddy born 1817.

Eliza born 1825, married Pat Griffin in 1843 at Kingstown. One of the witnesses was

Fanny Grogan

Possibly also the parents of <u>Mary Pew</u> dob app 1816 who married Pierce Byrne at Glassdole in 1836. One of the witnesses was **Frances Grogan**

James Grogan is the immediate lessor for mother Elizabeth Pew in Kingstown. She lives there with Denis Fox 1831-1851. John apparently died bef 1831.

1829 Edward Pugh 1829 Sandyford RC **1850** Edward is in the Kingston WH, born 1830

1847 John (Johannes) Pew 1847-1872 -marriage records say Edward is his father, and witness at wedding is Eliza Cunningham John is in the Workhouse-address Thomas Street- says age 30, does not match his death records-occupation Fitter

1871 Marries Elizabeth Leggatt- address Thomas Street—she is underage and I suspect they married in the COI and later after having their 2nd child went back to RC church* However, according to date of death she would have been 25. Occupation of groom-carpenter.

bef 1872 James-son b before 1872, on James Street. He is on the same baptism sheet at Edward. I believe he is buried in Deansgrange Cemetery 1872-1936 d in St Anne's Hosp age 64 laborer, widower. Wife Bridget 1872-1926, d WH, "late of Graceby Lane"

1872 Edward is born 1872 and father John has already died at the age of 25, address 43 James Street

1901-1916 Edward is in and out of prison- address where he was born is Thomas Street (?) His occupation is harness maker.

1908 Elizabeth is living in Summerhill

1911 Elizabeth is working as a cook for a Pawn Shop owner from Kilkenny, in Summerhill, widowed

1920 Elizabeth dies, son Edward lives at 38 Coombe

Edward was married twice, both of his wives were also in and out of prison and workhouses, both South and North Dublin.

Agnes Jordon (Also listed as **Agnes Lillie**) b 1876, married to Edward Pugh 1872- religion, date of birth, place of birth and religion varied. born on James Street. 1901 Census says they are both from Dublin, both can read and write. Address Dublin Street, Balbriggan Urban. 1911 Census Living with Donnelly family, Cranwell, McManus, Joseph Clarke, widower from Meath. Assumed she is divorced.

Julia Fermoyle b 1858 in Leeds, Yorkshire England 1911 census Julia from Yorkshire is married to Edward Pugh. He is a harness maker, married 2 years. She was married before in 1903 and had 4 children, 2 living. Her address is Summerhill, same as his mother's. She dies in an asylum in 1915.

Rose Pew, daughter of Luke and Mary Pew, who must have moved from Dublin

James ²1824 (son of Thomas and Anne) m. Mary Ann Byrne in 1844 and had 11 children. He died in 1882 and is buried in James and his family lived between Wickow and the Kingstown area. Buried in Deansgrange cemetery with wife and son Edward. According to their children's records, James **occupation** was a quarry man or stone cutter.

Time Line of James and Mary Ann Byrne

It appears that James b. 1824 was in trouble with the law as a teenager and sent to Australia for seven years in 1838. Seems pretty harsh for the crimes, which to me would indicate that they were very poor.

1837 He was caught stealing candles and also with the intent to steal clothes. Did time in Kilmainham Prison. Records show he was 11 and 12 but he was 13 and 14 at that time.

1838 Caught stealing fruit out of a garden with another 14 year old named Patrick Dowling. B Malloy Esq. filed charges. The boys got one month confinement in Kilmainham.

1838 Strong Suspicion of Committing Robberies (with 3 other boys/men) Time in Kilmainham

1838 Breach of the Peace Sent to Kilmainham

1838 Having a stolen purse in his possession

1838 Vagrancy 5 times/B Malloy Esq. -- Sentenced to 7 years transportation - Sentenced to 7 years transportation

1844 married Mary Ann Byrne-they didn't have children until 1849

1849 John, born Kingstown

1851 Bridget m. John Westcott in 1872, a sea man, in the Monkstown Church of Ireland. The rest of the family appears to be RC.

1852 Marianne m. John Williams, a stonecutter in 1872 in Glasthule

1853 Elizabeth m. Laurence Upton in 1873 at Ballybrack

1854 James Wicklow – There are two birth records, James and Jane, but on close inspection they are the same.

He was in the North Dublin Union in 1865 and in Kilmainham in 1875 for being disorderly in a public house.

1856 Thomas b. Bray- records are found for Thomas b in Wicklow, living in Liverpool in 1911. His wife is Rose Ann, from Liverpool, and he has four children, Marg age 24, Catherine age 23, Christopher age 21, and Ethel age 19.

1858 Mary A requested help getting clothes so she could go out of the house- refused. Not sure this is the correct family but they did have a lot of trouble.

1859 Charles b. Bray -trouble with the law 1876-1887-see below

1861 Joseph *rootsireland records say Stephen but it is clear on the actual record that it's Joseph-* b. Bray. There is a Joseph who married Angelina Spring/Sprigg in England and he was the father of Bertram from Birmingham who was in Dublin in the early 1900's.

1863 Edward Edward b. 1863 in Bray. There is a death record for Edward Pugh, 1862-1866 from Bray Head I suspect a discrepancy in dates. He is also buried in Deansgrange Cemetery with his parents

1865 Mary Ann starts having trouble with the law

1866 Catherine m Patrick Hoey in 1939. There is also a record for a Catherine with the same birth date that was in the prison records for being a victim of abuse. Had trouble with the law 1887-1903.

1869 Patrick born in Glasthule.

There are also the following records that are probably James.

1875 James Pugh b. 1818 age 57 in Kingston, Res. Albert Road, Kingston Indecent Assault on 9 yr old daughter. Kilmainham

Victims name Cath Pugh she was born 1866.

1876 James Pugh b. 1816 age 60 laborer res Kingston sick Rathdown Union Workhouse

1882 James Pugh 1812 age 70 sick born in Kingston. Died in Rathdown Union Workhouse of brain disease

The date of birth does not match James, but the name of Catherine matches.

1899-1902 Mary Anne in trouble with the law

Charles (1859), appears to be the son of James and Mary Anne Byrne. Kilmainham Prison unless stated otherwise.

1876 no date of birth, Charles Pugh was a victim of assault by Patrick White

1876 dob 1858 Age 18 from Bray Co Wicklow Assaulted a police constable

1877 dob 1858 Age 19 from Bray Head, Kingston. Assault: Victims name James Pugh- 2 cal months of hard labor- Probably his father?

1878 dob 1859 Age 19 from Bray Head Residence Kingston Assault police constable

1878 dob 1859 Age 19 from Bray, Wicklow-Residence Kingston. Drunk and disorderly

1879 from Bray, Wicklow-Residence Kingston. Assault Constable-Mcaleish

1879 dob 1860 from Bray, Wicklow-Residence Kingston Drunkenness

1881 dob 1859 age 22 Malicious Assault Victim Mary A Pugh -sister?

1881 dob 1859 age 22 Obscene Language

1881 dob 1859 age 22 Profane Language- assault female Richmond-Bridewell

1882 dob 1859 age 23-in prison index

1883 dob 1860 age 22 Assault police

1885dob 1860 age 25 Residence Kingston Obscene Language

1885dob 1861 age 24 Residence Kingston Assault PC

1886 dob 1860 age 25 Residence Kingston Profanity

1887 dob 1863 age 24 in prison records

1887 dob 1862 age 25 b. Kingston- in prison index

1887 dob 1862 age 25 b. Kingston-residence Kingston-assault police

1887 dob 1863 age 24 b. Bray, Kingston, Drunk

Family of James Pugh 1854 m Bridget Hogan 1882- James was a Van Driver and was also a soldier when they married. Also moved information to Sailor and Soldier File. Unknown when they died, would have been after 1911 as they were in the census records.

James and Bridget had the following children:

Bridget Mary b 1893 m William Gibson 1916 born in Dublin

James Joseph 1895-1906 Dublin

John Christopher b 1897 m Mary Macken 1918 Dublin

Thomas Christopher b 1900 m Elizabeth Morrisey 1922 Dublin

Patrick 1905 Dublin
