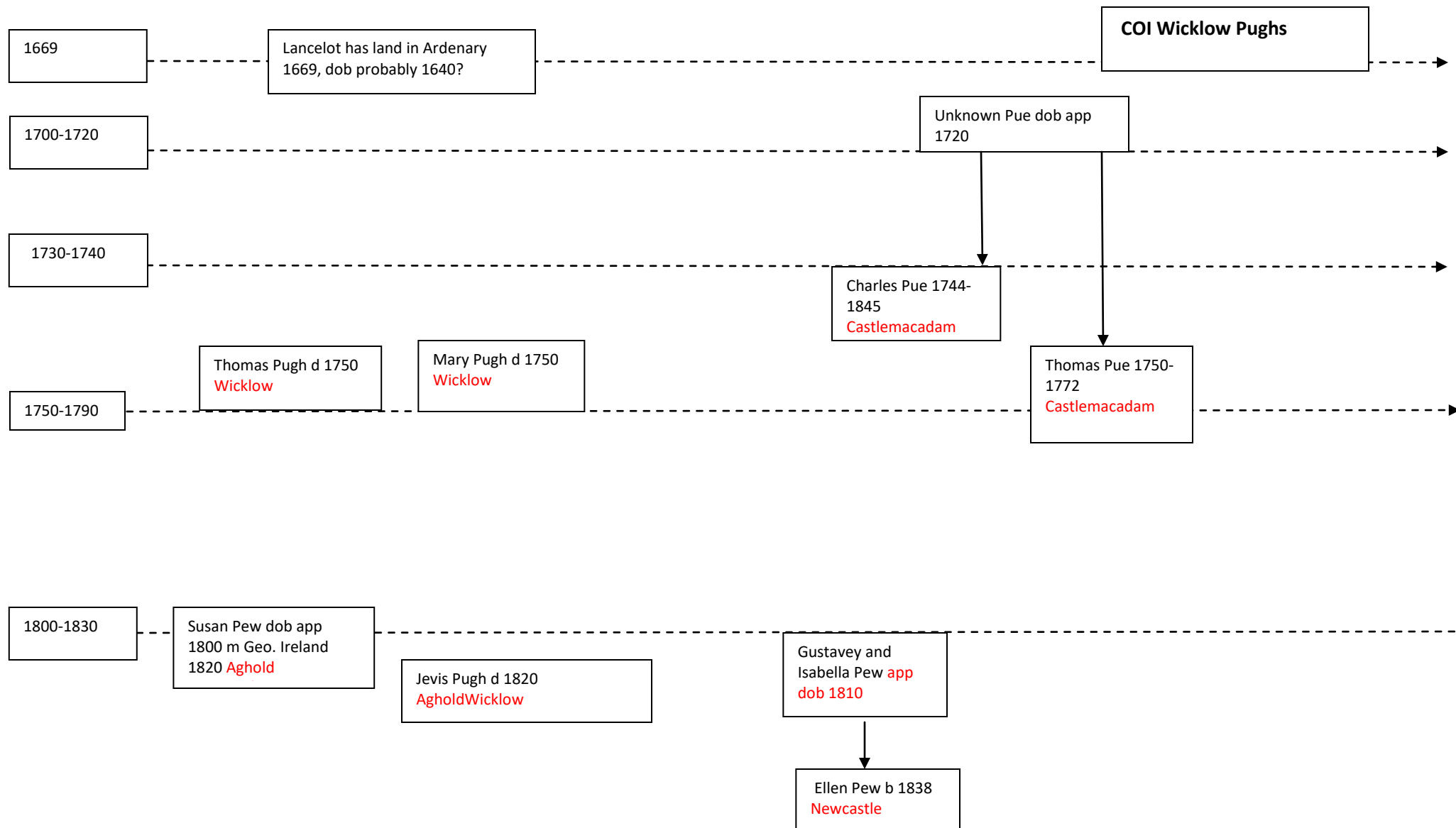
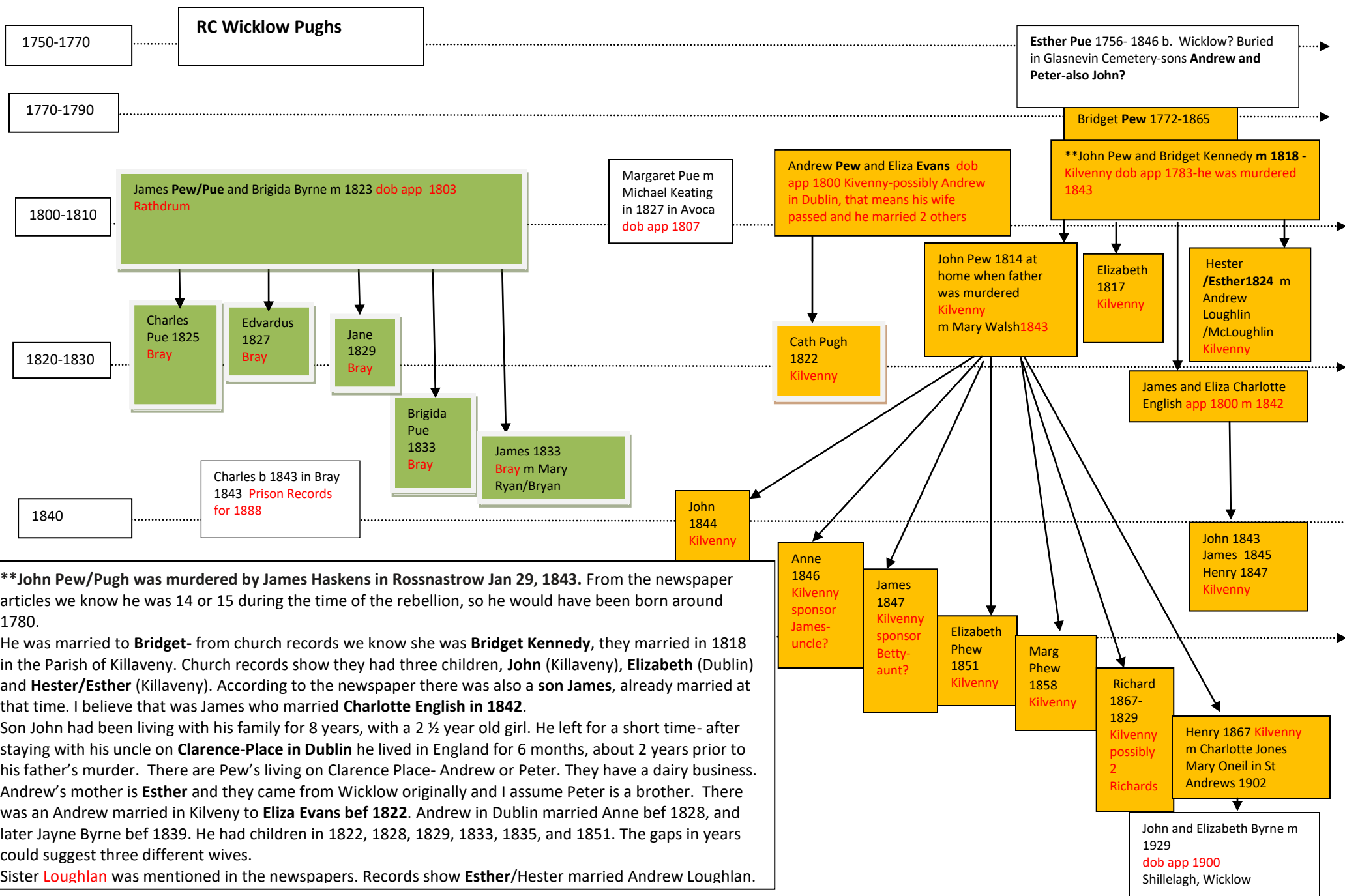


Wicklō Pue / Pew / Pugh Timeline



Wicklōw Pue/Pew/Pugh Timeline



****John Pew/Pugh was murdered by James Haskens in Rossnastrow Jan 29, 1843.** From the newspaper articles we know he was 14 or 15 during the time of the rebellion, so he would have been born around 1780. He was married to **Bridget**- from church records we know she was **Bridget Kennedy**, they married in 1818 in the Parish of Killaveny. Church records show they had three children, **John** (Killaveny), **Elizabeth** (Dublin) and **Hester/Esther** (Killaveny). According to the newspaper there was also a **son James**, already married at that time. I believe that was James who married **Charlotte English in 1842**. Son John had been living with his family for 8 years, with a 2 ½ year old girl. He left for a short time- after staying with his uncle on **Clarence-Place in Dublin** he lived in England for 6 months, about 2 years prior to his father's murder. There are Pew's living on Clarence Place- Andrew or Peter. They have a dairy business. Andrew's mother is **Esther** and they came from Wicklōw originally and I assume Peter is a brother. There was an Andrew married in Kilveny to **Eliza Evans bef 1822**. Andrew in Dublin married Anne bef 1828, and later Jayne Byrne bef 1839. He had children in 1822, 1828, 1829, 1833, 1835, and 1851. The gaps in years could suggest three different wives. Sister **Loughlan** was mentioned in the newspapers. Records show **Esther/Hester** married Andrew Loughlan.
